STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICK UP:

- If your child rides the school bus, they are dropped off and picked up in the alley.
- If you drop your child off at school or pick them up, you need to use the east side of the building on Bush Street (courtyard). Children enter through the courtyard door in the morning and can be picked up either from the Activity Center door or the playground (depending on the weather). Please do not use the alley for drop off or pick up. The alley is for buses only.
- If there is a change <u>during the school day</u> for how your child will get home (i.e. they were to ride the bus, but you are now picking them up.), please contact Amy in the office by fastdirect, texting 507-329-7464, or calling 507-662-5860. Amy will then let the teacher know. The teacher may be too busy to check their phone for messages. We don't want a message to be missed and for your child to either be on the bus by mistake or waiting for you when they should have been on the bus. However, if you know of a change in advance (not the day of), you can just let your child's teacher know. Amy only needs to know if it's a change from when you sent your child off to school that morning.

HAVE YOU HEARD ABOUT SCRIP?

At Immanuel we have a program where you buy gift cards and then a percent of what you buy goes into an account to help pay your child's tuition or hot lunch. The card that you purchase is for the full value of what you purchased. What happens is that the business you are buying the gift certificate from gives a portion of their proceeds back to the school. Disbursement from this account is done 2 or 3 times a year by the scrip coordinator, Stacie Soleta. Both local and national businesses participate. Scrip orders are due Monday mornings by 8:00 to Amy in the office or your child's teacher and they will be ready to be picked up the following Monday. There is a one dollar processing fee that enables us to give the whole percentage back to families. Check out this website to see what is available: www.raiseright.com.
